Before Pilate Art thou the King of the Jews?

Matthew 27:11-12

:11 And Jesus stood before the governor: and the governor asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And Jesus said unto him, Thou sayest. :12 And when he was accused of the chief priests and elders, he answered nothing.

John 18:33-38

- :33 Then Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called Jesus, and said unto him, Art thou the King of the Jews?

:38 Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault at all.

:19 The high priest then asked Jesus of his disciples, and of his doctrine. :20 Jesus answered him, I spake openly to the world; I ever taught in the synagogue, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said nothing.
